Qualification & Steps for Applying for Doctor of Chiropractic

Qualifications to be licensed in the State of Mississippi:

1. Graduate of an approved chiropractic college recognized by Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE).
2. Sixty (60) hours of undergraduate college work or pre-chiropractic college work
3. Passage of Parts I, II, III, IV and Physical Therapy of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners examination
4. Good moral character

Process for licensure for the chiropractor:

1. Complete application online and pay the \$100 application fee.
2. Official transcript of pre-chiropractic hours sent by college,
3. Official transcript of chiropractic college hours sent by college,
4. Certified copy of chiropractic college diploma,
5. Payment of \$200 examination fee online
6. Official copy of score report from National Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
7. Pass the jurisprudence examination given by the Mississippi Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
