Qualification & Steps for Applying for Doctor of Chiropractic

Qualifications to be licensed in the State of Mississippi:

- 1. Graduate of an approved chiropractic college recognized by Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE).
- 2. Sixty (60) hours of undergraduate college work or pre-chiropractic college work
- 3. Passage of Parts I, II, III, IV and Physical Therapy of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners examination
- 4. Good moral character

Process for licensure for the chiropractor:

- 1. Complete application online and pay the \$100 application fee.
- 2. Official transcript of pre-chiropractic hours sent by college,
- 3. Official transcript of chiropractic college hours sent by college,
- 4. Certified copy of chiropractic college diploma,
- 5. Payment of \$200 examination fee online
- 6. Official copy of score report from National Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
- 7. Pass the jurisprudence examination given by the Mississippi Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
